Teresa Zamboni Receives Nomination for LPGA's Southeast Section Teacher of the Year Award

Award Honors Women Golf Instructors Dedicated to Excellence in Golf

(Daytona Beach, FL – September 18, 2007) — Ladies' Links Fore Golf partner Teresa Zamboni has been nominated for one of the LPGA's top regional teaching awards, the Southeast Section Teacher of the Year Award.

Zamboni is a 12-year veteran of the LPGA and received the LPGA's Class A Teaching & Club Professionals designation in 2000. In 2007 she joined Ladies' Links Fore Golf, LLC, an organization whose mission is to empower women golfers by providing them support, instruction and strategies to improve their golf games and their mental and physical conditioning.

Prior to joining Ladies' Links Fore Golf, Zamboni was the golf academy director for one of the nation's most prestigious golf courses, the LPGA International Golf Course in Daytona Beach. There she was recognized for her innovations in developing exceptional golf instructional programs and curriculum, Learn and Play clinics, and for the integration of fitness training into golf education.

Zamboni joined the LPGA Teaching & Club Professionals in 1994 and was nominated LPGA Teacher of the Year in 2005 & 2006. She has participated in more than 50 LPGA T & CP sanctioned tournaments throughout the United States, including the LPGA Futures Tour from 1998 to 2001. She also has been a frequent host for LPGA teaching events and programs and has chaired a number of LPGA committees.

Zamboni also is a certified personal fitness trainer (IFPA), an Officer and Board Member for USGA/LPGA Girls Golf Club at LPGA International, and is the author of a Golf Academy Instruction Handbook used for golf schools and extended programs.

The LPGA Teacher of the Year awards were established in 1958. Since that time the award has been given annually to the woman golf professional who has most exemplified her profession during the year. The candidate must be an LPGA Teaching & Club Professional Class A or Master Professional member primarily engaged in the teaching of golf at a country club, golf club, or golf range. She must have been active in LPGA section and/or national events and must have made significant contributions in one or more of the following areas: junior golf, senior golf, women's golf, men's golf, special populations and students of prominence. Award winners will be announced in October 2007.
